

# Temora discaudata



## Synonyms

*Calanus scutellatus* Dana, 1849

## Size

Female: 1.69 - 2.00 mm

## Genus notes

- Cephalosoma is typically widest and deepest part of the prosoma, flattened
- 2 slender postal filaments

# Temora discaudata

(Flemin'g, 1889)

Phylum: Arthropoda  
 Order: Calanoida  
 Family: Temoridae

## Size

Length: 1.0 - 1.9 mm

## Male

- 9-segmented antennae
- 1st post-somite pointed and slightly symmetrical
- 2nd post-somite (basis of 1st antenna) is wide, the terminal segment is flattened and has 4 marginal spines
- 3rd post-somite of 1st antenna is hood-like and shallowly indentate
- 4th post-somite almost symmetrical, with long slender caudal rami
