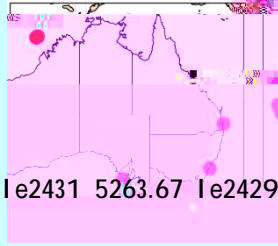
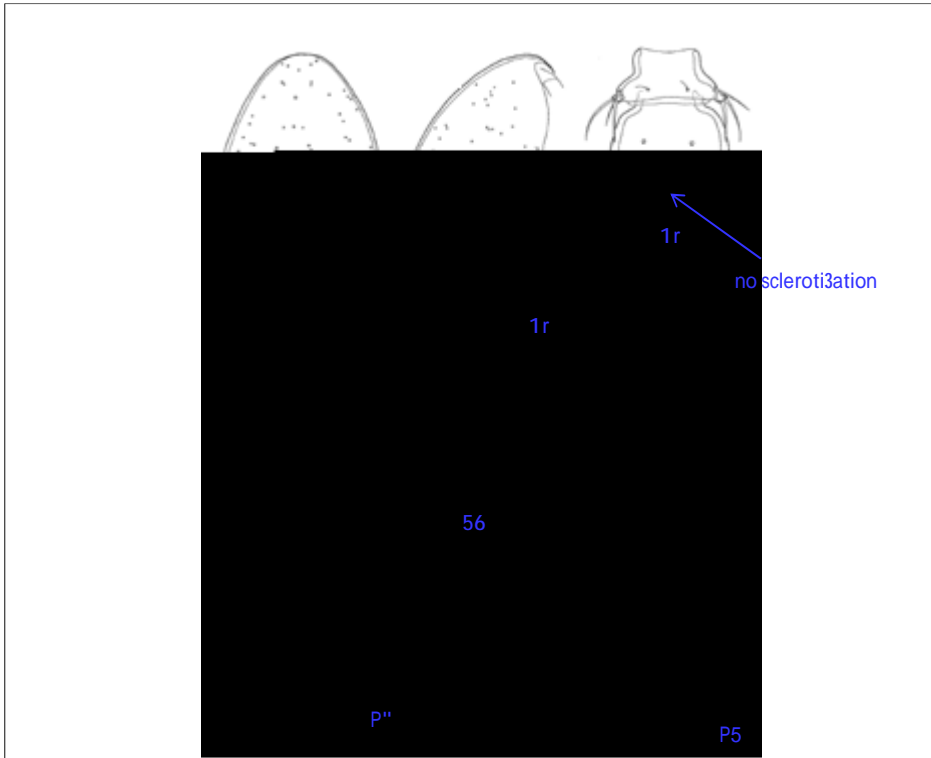

 Female: 0.42-0.50 mm

Genus notes

- Promose & urosome of female 5-segmented! urosome of male 7-segmented
- Prosome elongate to elongate-oval
- 1<sup>st</sup> antenna short with reduced number of segments
- 2<sup>nd</sup> antenna (segmented with terminal segment shorter than that of first segment) and 1 complete (5 sub-terminal elements)
- First maxilla small
- 2<sup>nd</sup> maxilla small
- All palp and telopod clasp in other species
- P3-P4 telopods and endopods essential (segmented and 5th segment free segment, small rod or knob-shaped, or represented by 1 seta)
- P2 (3 & 4 of some species terminated with a conical process with 2 apical spines)
- No distinction between adult and juvenile for genital openings & count urosome somites
- Urosome generally slender

- 2<sup>nd</sup> osseous element chitinized
- Prosome 2.4\* length of urosome
